Concept Design Project Update: October 2023

During the month of October, the Town of Hampton and design team held two public listening sessions to present project progress and solicit public feedback. The focus of the sessions was on the project guiding principles and the proposed space types and uses to be included in the final design.

During the sessions, Placework presented project progress do date, followed by a public question and answer session. Additional feedback was collected through a series of interactive boards (pictured at right) allowing session attendees to provide input via stickies and post-its.

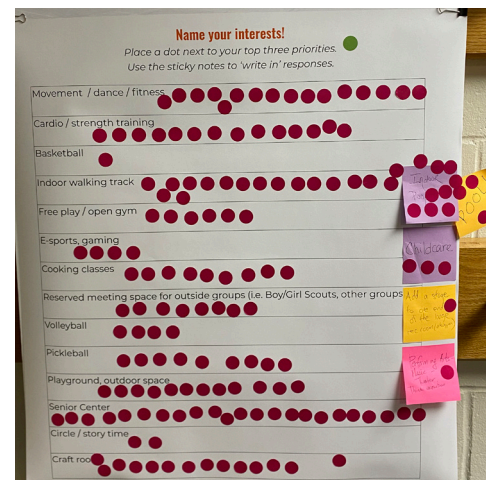
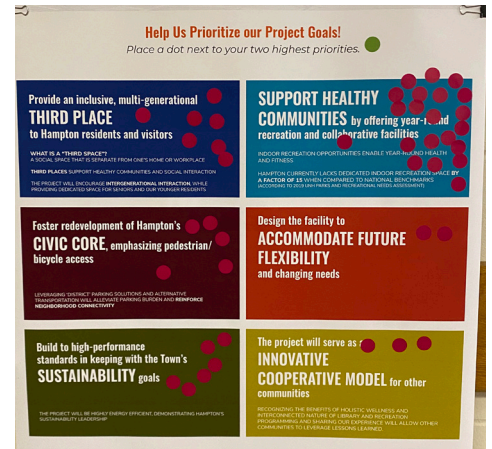
Key takeaways from the session included:

- There was a strong interest in dedicated space for Seniors.
- The “gym” shown should be considered as a multi-purpose space, rather than exclusively athletic facility.
- Indoor movement/dance/fitness activities were popular.
- Parking availability and impacts to Academy Avenue should be studied as the design progresses.
- Several community members expressed interest in an indoor pool. This is not currently being considered in the project.
- Consider spaces for the arts (i.e. soundstage etc..) in the design.
- Design should promote flexibility of all spaces.

Working with the Town, the design team will assess feedback from the public sessions, make agreed-upon adjustments, and develop concept designs for the Hub.
